BREATH ANALYSIS OPERATOR TRAINING (8 HOURS)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Breath Analysis Operator Course trains police officers in the operation of evidential breath test instruments. The program presents information on the effects of alcohol on the human body, operational procedures, Vehicle and Traffic Law pertaining to DWI enforcement, and pertinent case law. Successful students will receive a Breath Analysis Operator Permit which will expire three years from the date of issuance.

IMPORTANT: Any officer who registers to attend this course must have an OneNet account established with the ISP Breath Alcohol Operator (BAO) section. This is the method that ISP issues the BA Operators License after successful completion of the course and allows officers to track their training.

If you don't have a OneNet account, email <u>isp.bao.training@illinois.gov</u> with name, agency and work email address. Officers must establish the account **a minimum of two weeks** prior to the class. Please note the MTTU IV must provide a roster to ISP BAO two week prior to the class.
