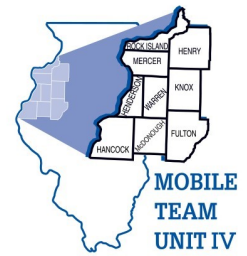

# 8-HOUR EXPENDABLE BATON: INSTRUCTOR DEVELOPMENT

### Course Description:

This one day, 8-hour course will provide students with instructor level training in the use of an expendable baton, a one-piece straight baton, or an other manufacturer's department-approved baton.

#### Topics:

- Use of Force discussion (review of 720 ILCS 5/7-5)
- Teaching methods
- Baton nomenclature and escalation chart
- Balance, stance, and patterns of movement
- Grips and methods of carry
- Blocking and striking
- Baton draws and retention
- Instructor teach-backs

**PLEASE NOTE:** Students should wear appropriate workout attire and bring their duty belts and department-issued expandable batons with them to class. Baton only and no other weapons will be allowed into the training facility.
