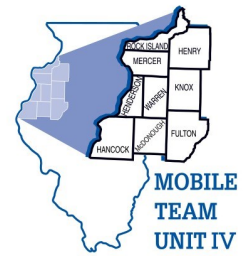

**PURPOSE OF COURSE:** This one- day, 8-hour program has been designed by Echelon Front based on "Extreme Ownership" written by Jocko Willink and Leif Babin. All material is copywritten by Echelon Front. This course will be a collaboration between Echelon Front instructors and the NEMRT Instructor CAIR Team. This collaboration will examine the principles of Extreme Ownership as applied directly to Illinois Law Enforcement through case scenarios.

**COURSE OVERVIEW:** This course has been designed by Echelon Front in collaboration with the Certified Law Enforcement Instructor CAIR Team, to provide officers with additional methods and information for development of leadership skills at all rank levels. - Decentralized Command: examine growth as a leader at all levels, task force models.
- Leading Up and Down the Chain of Command
- Decisive decision making
