40 HOUR BASIC EVIDENCE TECHNICIAN PROGRAM

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This program will provide students with an overview of the most up-to-date, scientifically sound methods for identifying, documenting, and collecting evidence encountered by law enforcement crime scene service units.

This course will be offered to sworn personnel of law enforcement, sheriff's and public safety agencies that want to develop basic evidence technician capabilities.

Registration must be made by the Agency Head or their designee; officers will not be allowed to enroll themselves. There will only be 20 slots available for this class.

MTTU IV will monitor submissions for this class. MTTU IV member agencies will be given priority on the final roster. In the event the class reaches the maximum enrollment of 20 officers a waiting list will be established. The final roster will be determined by MTTU IV and will not be based solely on the earliest registrations. Registration will close on May 5, 2025 at 4:00 PM; the final roster will be compiled and proper notifications will be made.

I have been a police officer in Illinois for over 35 years. I spent seven years with the North Western Railroad Police. I then went to the Village of Wheeling Police for 23 years until I retired in 2009 as a Sergeant. I then took a job with the Village of Inverness Police as Patrolmen. I have been a working ET for over 28 years. I have completed 280 hours of advanced forensic training at Northwestern University Traffic Institute.

While at Wheeling I spent 9 years as the Assistant Forensic Supervisor for the North Regional Major Crimes Task Force (NORTAF) working on over 90 murder investigations. I have been teaching for NEMRT for over 20 years and currently teach the following courses; 40 hour basic ET class, 8 Hour footwear evidence workshop, 8 hour basic latent print workshop, 3 day advanced evidence classes and an 8 hour child abuse awareness workshop. I have completed the 40 Hour Field Training Officer course and the 40 Hour Instructor Development course. I have been recognized by the Cook County Court system as an expert witness for crime scene processing at three different murder cases. I have also taught classes for the College of Lake County, Illinois State Police and for several local police departments.
