# 16-HOUR GROUND FIGHTING CONTROL TACTICS FOR ADMINISTRATORS AND SUPERVISORS

### **Course Description:**

This two day, 16-hour course has been designed to teach Police Administrators and Supervisors the "lighter" control techniques of the Ground Fighting Control Tactics curriculum. Students will learn ground basics, escort positions, and how to escape headlocks, chokeholds, and common grips and grabs. Officers will also be given training in the back position where they will learn a handcuffing platform that conforms to 720 ILCS 5/7-5.5 Prohibited use of force by a peace officer.

#### Per Board approval, this Class Meets the following Mandatory Training Key Guidelines.

Constitutional Use of Law Enforcement Authority—1.5 hours; Use of Force De-escalation Techniques—6 hours (6 scenario-based); Laws Concerning Stops, Searches, and the Use of Force—1 hour; Officer Safety Techniques, including Cover, Concealment and Time—4.5 hours (4.50 scenario-based) hours.

#### Instructors:

The instructors for this program are retired police supervisors. Sergeant John Hutson (Des Plaines Police Department) and Sergeant Dan Meshensky (South Elgin Police Department). Both instructors hold advanced ranking in Garcie/Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu, a discipline that has greatly impacted martial arts training since the early 1990s.
