### **MTTU IV Tactical Patrol Officer Certification Course**

6 Day – 48 Hour

Day 4 – Rescue Task Force/Active Threat Scenario Based Training

Day 5 – MACTAC/Urban Tactics

#### Day 6 – High Risk Traffic Stops/Urban Tactics

The Tactical Patrol Officer End User Series is a training and recognition initiative that provides a 6-day 48hr training and certification initiative designed to provide officers with the ability to obtain all the required state mandated hands-on, scenario-based training requirements in one course.

To accommodate agencies' challenging schedule and staffing requirements, this 48-hour course will be presented in three 2-day sessions, allowing each agency to minimize the impact on staffing levels. Attending Officers **MUST attend all 2-Day classes** to register for this program and get the listed mandates.

The training will be held at several locations during the six days, which will include Macomb, Monmouth, and possible northern area of the MTTU IV Region. Locations may change based on availability and students will be notified of any changes.

Session Two: June 9-10, 2025, 9am-5pm - Training site TBD

Session Three: June 23-24, 9am-5pm - Training site TBD

Completion of the course will not only provide **45+ Scenario & Hands-On Mandate Hours** but will also certify attending officers as Tactical Patrol Officers (TPO), recognized by the Illinois Tactical Patrol Officers Association. Each graduating officer will receive a TPO Certificate and be eligible to purchase and wear the TPO Uniform Pin.
