

### SEXUAL ASSAULT INVESTIGATOR TRAINING (DAY 2)

#### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The course will focus on response and investigation of sexual assault. The training will address trauma and the neurobiology of the brain. Rape myths surrounding sexual assault cases will be discussed and addressed. There will be a focus on what it means to be victim centered and trauma informed and how to conduct trauma informed interviews with victims. The training will also address defendant interviews and considerations when dealing with offenders charged with sex crimes and considerations in report writing. Investigation tips as to hospital protocol and the role of rape advocates will also be addressed. Social Media and evidence gathering from the internet will be discussed. The training will stress the importance of being trauma informed and victim centered to avoid re-traumatization of the victim.

This class is required for every sexual assault investigator every 3 years. Trauma Informed Initial Response course must have been taken before taking this course. Instructors prefer you take their class on the previous day.
