VEHICLE RECLAMATION FOR POLICE

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course provides the latest information on the applicable statute, case law and procedures required by the Secretary of State to process these vehicles properly.

The goals of this course are to train officers for the complex duties involved in understanding and processing vehicles that are abandoned, junked, towed seized and otherwise left unattended by their owners. This course prepares officers to efficiently and correctly process Vehicle Reclamation cases.

Student Performance Objectives

- Students will know the definitions of abandoned, antique, derelict, flood, hazardous, inoperable, junk, and rebuilt vehicles.
- Students will know the different types of Illinois titles and certificates of purchase.
- Students will know the current laws allowing for police to authorize the towing of vehicles.
- Students will know all vehicle reclamation statutes contained in Chapter 4 of the I.V.C.
- Students will know how and when a vehicle may be reclaimed after towing/impoundment.
- Students will know the processes involved in disposing of unclaimed vehicles after towing/impoundment.
- Students will know how complete all paperwork required of the Secretary of State's regarding vehicle reclamation matters.
- Students will know dissemination of records issues regarding LEADS and NLETS records and how to avoid violating non-dissemination rules.
