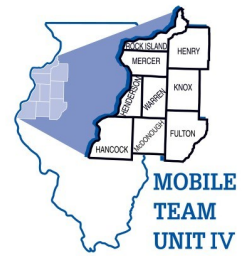

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Breath Analysis for Alcohol Training Course trains police officers in the operation of evidential breath test instruments. The program presents information on the effects of alcohol on the human body, operational procedures, Vehicle and Traffic Law pertaining to DWI enforcement, and pertinent case law. Successful students will receive a Breath Analysis Operator Permit which will expire three years from the date of issuance.
