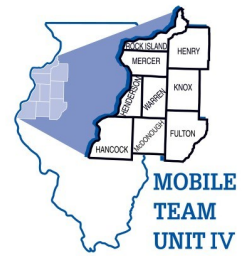

40 HR BASIC EVIDENCE TECHNICIAN COURSE

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This five-day, 40-hour program has been designed by MTU IV, along with an expert practitioner from the field of evidence collection, to introduce newly assigned crime scene technicians to various evidence identification, documentation, and collection techniques needed to properly process a crime scene.

The goal of this course is to give attendees a firm understanding of how evidence relates to a crime scene investigation. Officers will be shown the basic functions of a standard SLR digital camera and how to properly document a crime scene photographically. Officers will learn how to recover latent fingerprints from various surfaces. Officers will also demonstrate the proper methods for documenting, photographing and collecting both 3D and 2D footwear/ tire impression evidence. Each officer will have a working knowledge of how to correctly process a death scene. Officers will have an understanding of DNA, Trace and Firearms.

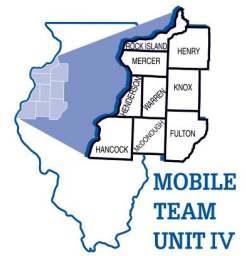

I have been a police officer in Illinois for over 35 years. I spent seven years with the North Western Railroad Police. I then went to the Village of Wheeling Police for 23 years until I retired in 2009 as a Sergeant. I then took a job with the Village of Inverness Police as Patrolmen. I have been a working ET for over 28 years. I have completed 280 hours of advanced forensic training at Northwestern University Traffic Institute.

While at Wheeling I spent 9 years as the Assistant Forensic Supervisor for the North Regional Major Crimes Task Force (NORTAF) working on over 90 murder investigations. I have been teaching for NEMRT for over 20 years and currently teach the following courses; 40 hour basic ET class, 8 Hour footwear evidence workshop, 8 hour basic latent print workshop, 3 day advanced evidence classes and an 8 hour child abuse awareness workshop. I have completed the 40 Hour Field Training Officer course and the 40 Hour Instructor Development course. I have been recognized by the Cook County Court system as an expert witness for crime scene processing at three different murder cases. I have also taught classes for the College of Lake County, Illinois State Police and for several local police departments.
